**I. EMENTA:** This course aims to provide to the student training and workup critical criminological studies in its various approaches (sociological, legal, anthropological, psychological), with emphasis on contemporary criminological debate. It also aims to point out the influence of criminological theories in political movements and in modern theories of crime and criminal law. Therefore, it aims to discuss the social production of crime and forms of administration of criminal justice, as well as analyze the situation of public security, the Judiciary and violent urban crime in Brazilian society, according to the main criminological theories.

**II. OBJETIVOS:** At the end of the course, students should be able to identify the historical trajectory of criminological thought, through the main theories and authors that have marked the development of the discipline, since its appearance. The approach of Criminology as part of transdisciplinary field of criminal science should also allow students an understanding of the relationship between crime and crime control in its various dimensions, enabling a critical view of criminal science in its various branches (Criminal Law, Criminology, Criminal Policy).

### **III. CONTEÚDO PROGRAMÁTICO**

**1st. Part I: History of the Criminological Thought** Criminology: concepts, objects and methods. The emergence of the knowledge about crime - Positive School and Classical School. The development of Criminal Sociology: Chicago School and Anomie's Theory. Theories of Differential Association (White Collar Crime) and Delinquent's Subcultures. The development of Criminal Psychology and Influences of Psychoanalysis. The Criminological Turn - Labeling Theory. Development of Critical Criminology. Criminal Psychiatry, Antipsychiatry Movement and Anti-Asylum Movement.

**2nd. Part: Contemporary Criminological Thought** The Inheritance of Critical Criminology and Criminal Policy Alternatives (Minimalism, Abolitionism, Garantism, Feminism, Realism and Left Marginal Realism). Post-Critical Criminology (Culturalism, Postmodernism, Criminology Recognition and other critical renovations). The Heritage of Defensivism and Punishing Criminal Policies (Law and Order, Zero Tolerance, Punishing Populism, Punishing Left, Criminal Law of the Enemy). Neurocriminologies.

**3rd. Part: Contemporary Topics in Criminology** (to be developed as an option) Violence and Public Safety in Contemporary Brazil. Violence against Women. Violence during Childhood and Adolescence. Drugs Criminal Policy. Restorative Justice and Crime Prevent Public Policies. Prison and Sentencing Alternatives. Social Movements' Criminalisation. Role of the Criminologist in the Criminal Justice System. Criminology and Art (Cinema, Literature and Music). White Collar Crimes. Organized Crime and Terrorism. Criminology and Human Rights. Sistema Penitenciário e Penas Alternativas

Movimentos Sociais e Criminalização.
