


WELCOME TO PUCRS!

We will then explore some of the major problems and key concepts of a philosophy of neuroscience, neurophilosophy, and neuroethics, focusing especially on recent theories of naturalism and normativity, such as those advanced by Berit Brogaard, Otavio Bueno, Barry Smith, Lucina Uddin, and John Sarnecki. No previous knowledge of philosophy of mind or neurophilosophy is required. All classes, readings and discussions will be conducted in English.</p> <p>Synchronous course: every Tuesday (from 8:45am to 11:15am / Brasília Time)</p>
