Research Opportunities for International Students

About

- The Research Placements program in Laboratories and Research Centers / Groups is an opportunity for international students to have professional practice in any academic areas with the direct supervision of PUCRS professors. This program has been conceived exclusively for international students who wish to boost their academic career during their mobility program.

- Flexible and convenient length;
- Pre-established activities between intern and professor;
- Close supervision and constant monitoring;
- Focus on academic achievements;
- New perceptions and applied methods in the intern's academic areas;
- Human, material and physical resources of excellence available.

Successful applicants will:

- Be duly enrolled in one of PUCRS' partner institutions;
- Be 18 years of age;
- Bear a valid passport;
- Meet the specific criteria of the project chosen.

Important information

- According to the existing laws of Brazil, an intern's total weekly workload must not be higher than 6h/day (30 hours/ week);
- The minimum / maximum length of a placement depends on each project;
- The complete job description will be discussed with the coordinating professors before the student's arrival;
- Language requirements will vary according to the project;
- The placement will be on a voluntary basis, so no compensation will be provided;
- Once an approval is issued by the coordinating professor, PUCRS will issue an acceptance letter. This document must be presented to the consular agent when applying for a visa to come to Brazil;
- The Office of International Cooperation - Academic Mobility Program will mediate the relationship between the student and the professor.
